- Many programs are planning to offer their virtual program/events for free as well as opening up to a lot more students attendees Some programs are offering a new price (less than original) that reflects the new virtual program costs
- Many programs are offering a different type of program or a series of events for students, instead of moving their traditional program fully online. Many are also changing the dates of their program.
- Tip: You can work with Underground Printing to package everything and send it out to your students to eliminate unnecessary exposure.
